Mount on Beams or Ledges

Hard to reach areas such as beams and ledges can be serviced with a grab stick used by animal control. The technician pictured here is using a noose type grab stick.

Heavy duty velcro is attached to the beam after removing any dust or foreign matter from the beam. The mating side of the Velcro attached to the station base holds it firmly to the beam.

Grab sticks with jaws will work equally well. Wire or nylon ties can also be used.

Some ledge areas, and/or difficult-to-reach areas may not facilitate the use of the Velcro and/or the grab stick technique. Such areas may have to be serviced using ladders and direct hand placement and retrievals.



Smaller Footprint Than Standard Bait Stations

The smaller footprint allows the JT EATON No. 902 TOP LOADER™ Bait Station to be placed closer to walls than most bait stations reducing the chance of damage by forklifts and other equipment.



Mount at Ground Level

The JT EATON No. 902 TOP LOADER™ Bait Station can be secured to fences with nylon ties or wires. Insert the ties or wires through openings at the top edge of the horizontal tube to help prevent the station from moving. Strong Polypropylene plastic resists damage from mowers and string trimmers.



Mount on Fence Rails

Mount the JT EATON No. 902 TOP LOADER™ Bait Station on fences and rails where rats and mice run.



Attach to Tree Branches

The JT EATON No. 902 TOP LOADER™ Bait Station can be secured to tree branches with nylon ties or wires. Insert the ties or wires through openings at the top edge of the horizontal tube to help prevent the station from moving.
